



Rental Groups – Facilities Available + Resources

The following is a list of facilities available at CHT for meetings, workshops, parties, retreats, team-building – or any special (or ordinary!) event. Please call to discuss your organization's individual needs. Included at the end are catering companies that have delivered here or used the Camp Kitchen.

Reservations fill up fast, so book in advance!

*Camp Holiday Trails is a camp for children with chronic illnesses and special health needs.
Your rental fees support our programs for children with special health needs.*

LODGING

Cabins (cabins 1 – 5) - There are five cabins that have **two separate rooms** on either side of a front porch. Each side sleeps **up to eight people** in bunk beds. Each room has air conditioning, heat and a fully accessible bathroom (remodeled fall '08) with toilet, sink and roll-in shower. **Must provide own linens. (cabins close mid-Nov thru mid-Mar)**

\$25/person/night, minimum of 6 people OR \$250/night for an entire cabin

Blazer Cabins – The two Blazer cabins are situated to the right side of the Pavilion. These cabins have **three** separate rooms each. **Blazer Girls cabin sleeps nine people; Blazer Boys cabin sleeps eleven people.** The bathroom facilities are located behind Cabin 4, which is directly to the left of the Pavilion. These cabins have electricity and air conditioning, **but no heat. Must provide own linens. (bathrooms close mid-Nov thru mid-Mar)**

\$20/person/night, minimum of 4 people OR \$100/night for an entire cabin

Med Staff Cabin, new in 2010 – Bunk Lodge & Family Lodge– The Med Staff Cabin is situated next to our Caretaker Cabin and behind Cabin 1. The Cabin has two sections, with separate entrances. You may rent either the Bunk Lodge or the Family Lodge or rent both Lodges. Both the Bunk and the Family Lodges sleep **up to eight people** in bunk beds. Each side has central air/heat, two fully accessible bathrooms, a great room and a kitchenette.

Must provide own linens. \$25/person/night + \$150 rental fee

Camping – Our designated areas for tent camping are in the large field between the pool and Sport Court and on TP Hill (includes a wooden sleeping platform and campfire circle) behind the Camp Office building. **These are the only areas designated for camping.** There are no bathroom facilities available on TP Hill. The bathrooms behind Cabin 4 may be used for those camping in the large field. **Maximum number of tents – field/10, TP Hill/10 (bathrooms close mid-Nov thru mid-Mar)**

\$15/person/night

MEETING ROOMS

Dining Hall/Meeting Room – The Dining Hall with large meeting room houses our kitchen (rents separately) and dining room area. The dining room capacity is 300 (but we only own 100 chairs!) and can be used as a meeting area, a dance floor, game room or a variety of other possibilities. There are two bathrooms, central heat & A/C.

\$375/day

(Weddings: Additional fee of \$100 applies to all weddings. Please note if you will need set-up time a day in advance of event as this requires reserving additional time at our facility.)

Kitchen – The commercial size kitchen may be used for basic food storage and preparation. This includes use of refrigerator, stove, sinks, and dishwasher. **Does not include food or kitchen staff.** Team-build to prepare meals or bring in staff and volunteers! Has heat and A/C.

\$200/day

Med Staff Cabin, new in 2010 – Bunk Lodge & Family Lodge - The Med Staff Cabin is situated next to our Caretaker Cabin and behind Cabin 1. The Cabin has two sections, with completely separate entrances. You may rent either the Bunk Lodge or the Family Lodge or both Lodges. Both the Bunk and the Family Lodges have large great rooms that can easily be used as meeting spaces for c. 20 people each. Each side has central air and heat and two fully accessible bathrooms plus a kitchenette (also has two sleeping areas – see above).

\$150/day/Lodge

OUTDOOR FACILITIES

Pavilion/Field/Sport Court w/campfire ring— Our covered Pavilion has a concrete floor and a front stage area with electrical outlets and overhead lighting. There are also benches, picnic tables, a charcoal grill and a campfire ring for your use. Bathroom facilities are located behind Cabin 4. The field is between the Pavilion and the Sport Court – the bowl shape makes for a great kick-ball game! Our Sport Court is a multi-use court (you can play basketball and volleyball) Basketball hoops and volleyball nets available upon request. **(Bathrooms close mid-Nov thru mid-Mar)**
\$250/day – includes all 3 areas

Pool – Our pool is available for rent Memorial Day through Labor Day.

You must provide a certified lifeguard for a ratio of 1 guard:25 swimmers
\$300/day

Waterfront – Our waterfront area includes an amphitheater with seating and a lakeside campfire. In addition, there is one secured dock and two floating docks. Fishing areas plus canoes and kayaks available.

You must provide a certified lifeguard.

\$175 /day – for full use OR \$75/evening - for a campfire without fishing or boats

TP Hill – This area is at the highest point of Camp. At the site, there is an extra large campfire circle, picnic area, sleeping platforms and outdoor stations. Accessed by short, but steep hiking trail.

\$175/day – for full use OR \$75/evening – for campfire only
